



Youth Experience Program

Purpose

The purpose of the Sport, Culture and Recreation Youth Experience Program is to enhance and provide opportunities for economically challenged youth through the provision of community based sport, culture and recreation field trips.

The program is designed to support youth with the opportunity to attend major attractions and events such as Science Centres, Museums, sporting events (WHL games, SJHL games, and CFL games). Other potential activities could include field trips to locations such as Heritage Parks, National Historic Sites, etc.

Community/Host Responsibilities:

- Develop a youth experience plan including activity/event, date and all arrangements
- Recruit and supply volunteers to supervise participants on the trip
- Ensure all volunteers are responsible
- Identify and recruit participants
- Obtain input from youth on what trip/event they will participate in
- Provide nutrition for youth
- Complete the follow-up and ensure the participants complete the evaluation forms provided.
- Support the grant guidelines
- Ensure there is adequate liability insurance coverage for your organization
- Recognize Lakeland District for Sport, Culture & Recreation and Saskatchewan Lotteries.

Available Assistance:

Funding available to each community/organization is dependent on the number of interest and applications received.

Youth Experience Field Trip Ideas but not limited to these:

Saskatchewan Roughrider Game, SJHL or WHL Game, Science Centre, Mackenzie Art Gallery, Royal Saskatchewan Museum, RCMP Heritage Museum, Regina Plains Museum

If there is a need to focus efforts in your community such as having disadvantaged youth participate in local events and programs, this grant can be used for that purpose.

Eligible Expenditures:

- Transportation of participants and volunteers to and from the event
- Nutrition/Meals for participants and volunteers on the day of the event
- Admission Fees of participants and volunteers to the event

Ineligible Expenditures:

- Capital expenditures, assistance for the construction, renovation, or repair of capital facility projects such as arenas, pools, parks, athletic fields, trails, buildings, grounds, etc.
- There will be no duplication of funding for opportunities currently funded through the Saskatchewan Lotteries Trust Fund
- Subsidization of wages for employees/staff honorariums
- National Coaching Certification
- EMS, athletic training, CPR or 1st aid training
- Property taxes
- Alcoholic beverages
- Cash prizes
- Uniforms, or personal items such as hats or sweatbands
- Conferences
- Training opportunities outside of Saskatchewan
