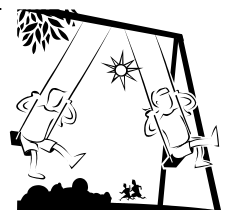
Only those applicants selected for an interview will be contacted. The successful applicants will be required to submit a current criminal record check.
